- Access to National level competition and seminars in the arts of Kendo, Iaido and Jodo.

Junior membership is available to members who are under the age of 16 years on the first of July of the membership year.

The QKR purchases public liability, professional indemnity and player injury insurance cover annually at considerable annual cost to its members. The benefit of this cover is only available to members of the Renmei. People training with your club that are not members are not covered by this policy. Please ensure that for your own and your clubs protection that all people training with you are members. A short period of leeway is accepted for beginners to determine whether they wish to pursue this martial art, please limit this to approximately one month.

If you have overseas visitors training with you for a few weeks to months and do not wish to invite them to pay membership, then please apply in writing on their behalf to the QKR for recognition as honorary members for that time.

Eligibility to participate in any AKR championship event in a year requires membership by December 31<sup>st</sup> of that membership year. The AKR will not bend this rule under any circumstances.

Grading opportunities are only offered to financial members of the AKR and QKR or to financial members of an IKF affiliate that can prove they are eligible to grade. To be eligible for a Dan grading, members must have been financial members of the Renmei for at least the minimum years required for eligibility immediately prior to presenting for the grading. The AKR council has developed the policy on grading eligibility and this policy will be placed on the QKR website for interested members. Failure to maintain membership will result in delays to grading eligibility.
